



## Preferred Drug List and Therapeutic Interchange Program (TIP)

A key **benefit of endorsing the Preferred Drug List** is that you can **avoid the authorization process** when you prescribe a non-preferred drug (see flowcharts below):



Here's a list of drug classes included in the DAW indicator that orthopedic, neurological, and hand surgeons commonly prescribe:

Proton Pump Inhibitor

*D4K*

Non-Barbiturate, Sedative-Hypnotics

*H2E*

Analgesics, narcotics

*H3A*

## Wrap-Around Formulary

The wrap-around formulary is **not included in the DAW indicator**. When prescribing drugs included in the wrap-around formulary, **prescribing from the PDL reduces your administrative burden** because doing so allows you to avoid the authorization process (see flowcharts below):
